The Manitoba Food Charter: Taking the Next Step

On March 14, 2005, over 40 individuals including Aboriginal people, academics, fishers, students, community gardeners, farmers, activists, politicians, local food retailers, community health workers, ministers, food action agencies, and seniors from urban, rural and northern Manitoba gathered at Crossways in Common to embark on a year-long conversation about food security in Manitoba.

One year later, the Manitoba Food Charter is nearing completion, having consulted with more than 70 groups from northern, rural and urban communities in Manitoba. Now, as we put pen to paper to create this one page statement on what Manitobans believe their food system should look like, we are inviting everyone back to Crossways on March 14, 2006 to envision what our next step should be.

Come for a one day, participatory workshop in which we will share stories of the past year and look ahead to decide priorities for action. **Your participation is important!** We will also be calling for new members on our steering committee and working groups!
