

FIRST TERM CALL FOR PROPOSALS FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE ENDOWMENT FUND

The Faculty of Architecture, at The University of Manitoba, invites submissions for the annual disbursement from the Faculty of Architecture Endowment Fund.

First Term Call for Proposals submission deadline: Wednesday, November 16, 2016.

The primary advantages to this early call for proposals will be to allow successful applicants additional lead time to develop their projects more fully, as well as confirm Endowment Fund Committee funding amounts thus allowing lead time to seek additional funding. Should an applicant not be successful for the First Term Call for Proposals, they will now have additional flexibility to utilize Endowment Fund Committee feedback to strengthen their proposal for resubmission to the Second Term Call for Proposals. The Endowment Fund Committee will review the submissions from the First Term Call for Proposals and determine the total extent of these initial award amounts, while retaining some of the funding for the Second Term Call for Proposals.

Second Term Call for Proposals submission deadline: Friday, March 3, 2016.

It is anticipated that there will be \$75,000-\$79,000 available to be awarded over the two periods. All funds awarded will be made available after March 31, 2017.
